Introduction of Regular Courses of Hiro C.D.C. **20 Easy Dressmaking** (women's course) The course I visited this time is "Easy Dressmaking

(women's course). The instructor is Ms. **Shihomi** Hamaguchi. Ms. Hamaguchi was born into a

family of proprietors of a dressmaking school that was founded first and closed last in Kure City. She was destined to take over the school from a young age. However, Ms. *Hamaguchi* majored in "literature," which had nothing to do with dressmaking, at university. The turning point in her life came when she was a freshman in college. Her father passed away. While continuing

her studies in literature, she learned

dressmaking from her mother.

There were many difficult things about running the school, such as when the neighborhood caught fire or when suspicious people appeared because it was an all-female school. On the other hand, there are many pleasant memories of going on trips and outings with students.

The reason why Ms. *Hamaguchi* is where she is now is because she had a strong will to "always be in front to protect her students." She has been teaching at this center for 8 years. Since the previous teacher had to quit due to family circumstances, she has continued to teach since then. All students are active and friendly with each other. There is also mutual teaching among students. It's a very good atmosphere. According to Ms. Hamaguchi, this course is based on "everyone getting along and having fun together." If you can make clothes that you like, that's all that matters. Because we don't want to do anything difficult, having fun is the most important thing. We deepen our relationships while chatting. Because it takes a considerable amount of time to finish one piece, participation in the Educational



Festival is planned once every two years. This is in line with Ms. *Hamaguchi*'s idea of "making one piece of clothing in a world that

is comfortable to wear for a long time and that suits your body at your own pace while having fun.
