

For People in the Resident Tax Exempt(Per Capita Basis)Households

Information on Emergency Support Benefits (50,000 yen per household) due to the soaring prices of electricity, gas, food, etc.

Procedures required for receiving the benefits

- Emergency Support Benefits (50,000 yen per household) due to the soaring prices of electricity, gas, food, etc. for households exempt from resident tax (per capita basis) and households with sudden changes in household finances from January to December, 2022.
- Procedures are required to receive the benefits.

Amount of benefit payment

50,000 yen per household

Benefit payment period

Approximately two to three weeks after Kure City receives the confirmation (or application).

Payment Eligibility and Whether an Application is Required

Households eligible for payment (either of the following applies)

Household which all members of the **"household are exempt from resident tax (per capita basis)"** in 2022.

Household whose income decreased from January to December, 2022 and became **"equivalent to resident tax exemption"** (household with sudden changes in household finances)

Confirmation documents will be sent to those eligible on **Wednesday, November 15, 2022.** (return required)

Households which registered as residents of Kure City **as of September 30, 2022** are eligible.

※Applications are required for households including those who moved into Kure City after January, 1, 2022.

Application Required



Application period: Until Tuesday, January 31, 2023

Please apply to the municipality where you are registered as a resident **at the time of application.**

※For those living in Kure City, application forms will be distributed on the Kure City website, at Kure City Hall, and each civic center.

Please check the back side for payment procedures and details of payment requirements.

Benefit Payment Procedures

I. Households exempt from resident tax (per capita basis) in 2022.

(1) **If all members of the household have** lived at their current address on or before January 1, 2022

- Eligible households will receive a confirmation letter from Kure City that includes details of benefits and items to be confirmed.
- Please check the contents and **return it to Kure City.**



【Checklist】

- ① Make sure there are no errors in the written bank account number for the benefit transfer.
- ② Make sure your household is not composed of only dependent relatives who are supported by a person who is subject to resident tax .

(2) **If someone in your household moved into Kure City on or after January 2, 2022**

- In order to receive the benefits, **application is required.**
- Please fill out the application form and submit it to Kure City along with required documents.



※If you live outside of Kure City as of the reference date (September 30, 2022), please apply at the relevant municipality.

II. Income decreased **unexpectedly** due to sudden changes in household finances, and households where all members of the households ※became exempt from residence tax (households with sudden changes in finances)

- In order to receive the benefits, **application is required.**
- Please fill in the necessary information on the application form and submit it by mail as much as possible along with the attached documents. (For COVID-19 measures)

※“**Equivalent to resident tax exemption**” means that the estimated annual income of each household member (any monthly income from January to December, 2022 x 12) is below the municipal resident tax per capita basis exemption level as shown below.

Estimated annual salary exempt from resident tax (in the case of Kure City)

Single-person household: 1 million yen or less Head of household and one dependent child: 1.56 million yen or less

Head of household, dependent spouse, and one dependent child: 2.057 million yen or less

! If you apply for the benefits due to an expected decrease in monthly income, you may be accused of fraud.



Please be careful about **“bank transfer fraud”** and **“identity theft”** for the temporary special benefits for resident tax exempt households.



If you receive a suspicious phone call or mail at your home or workplace, etc., claiming to be a staff from a prefecture, municipality, or national government, please contact the Kure City Consumer Affairs Center (25-3218), the nearest police station, or the police consultation service at #9110.
